## Disgyblion (GAD)



- Cyfanswm niferoedd disgyblion ar gofrestr yr ysgol Medi 2016 ydy 346 gan gynnwys 40 o ddisgyblion rhan amser yn y Meithrin.
- Mae poblogaeth PADD yr ysgol o dan 25%
- Mae hwn tua'r un peth â'r boblogaeth y flwyddyn gynt.
- Cyfanswm y GAD a roddir i'r ysgol hon o Ebrill 2016 i Fawrth 2017 yw £51,750

Mae'r ysgol yn gweithredu'r gweithgareddau canlynol er mwyn cefnogi disgyblion sy'n wynebu her tloedi ac amddifadedd:

- Monitro a gwerthuso'r ddarpariaeth i'r disgyblion hyn, hyfforddi staff i gyrraedd anghenion y disgyblion yma.
- Darparu staff i gefnogi anghenion y disgyblion yma.
- Mae'r corff llywodraethol yn archwilio'r gwariant grant yn gyson, gan ddilyn cyngor y GCA. Yn ogystal i hyn, mae'r gwariant yn cael ei fonitro gan yr awdurdod lleol.

# How we spend our Pupil Deprivation Grant

## (PDG)

- The total number of pupils on school roll for September 2016 is 346 including 40 part time Nursery pupils.
- The school's FSM population is under 25%
- This is around the same as the population for the previous year.
- The total allocation of PDG to this school from April 2016 to March 2017 is £51,750

The school undertakes the following activities in order to support pupils facing the challenges of poverty and deprivation:

- Monitoring and evaluating provision for these pupils, training staff to meet the needs of those pupils.
- Providing staff to support pupils the needs of those pupils.
- The school's grant spend is regularly scrutinised by the Governing Body, supported by advice from the EAS . In addition to this, the grant spend is monitored by the local authority.
